- working out the heart and purposes of God on the earth.
- maturing in love.
- Reveal God as Good.
- Who are you serving?
- 2. Bride: (John 3:29, Revelation 19:7)
- faithful lover.
- captured by beauty.
- committed and covenantal love.
- Reveal God as a God of Burning, Committed Love.
- Where is your loyalty?

- 3. Temple: (1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19; Ephesians 2:21)
- the dwelling place of God's presence.
- live a life for an audience of One.
- surrender and sacrifice are significant.
- Reveal God as a God of Refining Fire.
- How are you experiencing God at home?
- 4. Flock: (Luke 12:32; John 10:16; 1 Peter 5:2-3)
- we experience God's leadership, protection and provision.
- we are moved by His voice.
- we embrace His correction as good for us.
- Reveal God as a Wise and Trusted Shepherd.
- Where is God leading you?

- 5. House: (Hebrews 3:16, 10:21; 1 Peter 2:5)
- a place of unconditional love and acceptance.
- a place to grow.
- a place to be celebrated.
- Reveal God as a God of Strength and Protection.
- How are you empowering others?

#### 6. City: (Matthew 5:14)

- a place of refuge.
- a lifestyle of revealing our good works.
- a place of fulfilling purpose.
- Reveal God as a God of Mercy.
- How are you showing mercy?

- 7. Family: (Psalm 68:6, 107:4-7; 1 Peter 5:9)
- we discover identity.
- we develop maturity.
- we embrace destiny.
- we learn to serve others.
- Reveal God as a Good Father.
- In what ways are you expressing love and calling out identity in others?

Metaphors define Mission. Mission reveals Motives. Mission needs Methods.

A Body is motivated by Compassion. A Bride is motivated by Love. A Temple is motivated by <u>Purity</u>. A Flock is motivated by Security. A House is motivated by Strength. A City is motivated by Hope. A Family is motivated by Covenant.

#### Three Conclusions:

- 1. Our homes are formed by biblical metaphors and mission.
- 2. Our homes, attitudes, and lifestyle reveal the Kingdom of God.
- 3. To be formed by mission and motive you need to be prayerful, intentional and patient.
