# Our Goal:

By clarifying the empowered positions of a Christian (as described by Paul in his letter to the Ephesians) we will upgrade the quality of our believing and the quality of our testimony.





“4 Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes. 5 God decided in advance to adopt us into his won family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure. 6 For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and **seated us with him** in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.





7 So God can point to us in all future ages as examples of the incredible wealth of his grace and kindness toward us, as shown in all he has done for us who are united with Christ Jesus. Therefore, I implore you to **walk** in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called.... Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to **stand** firm against all strategies of the devil.”
