
C R O S S I N G OVER

"And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised. CROSSING OVER




Christ crossed over confronting fear with LOVE.
