- c. **Believe** - **Mark 1:15, James 1:22-23**

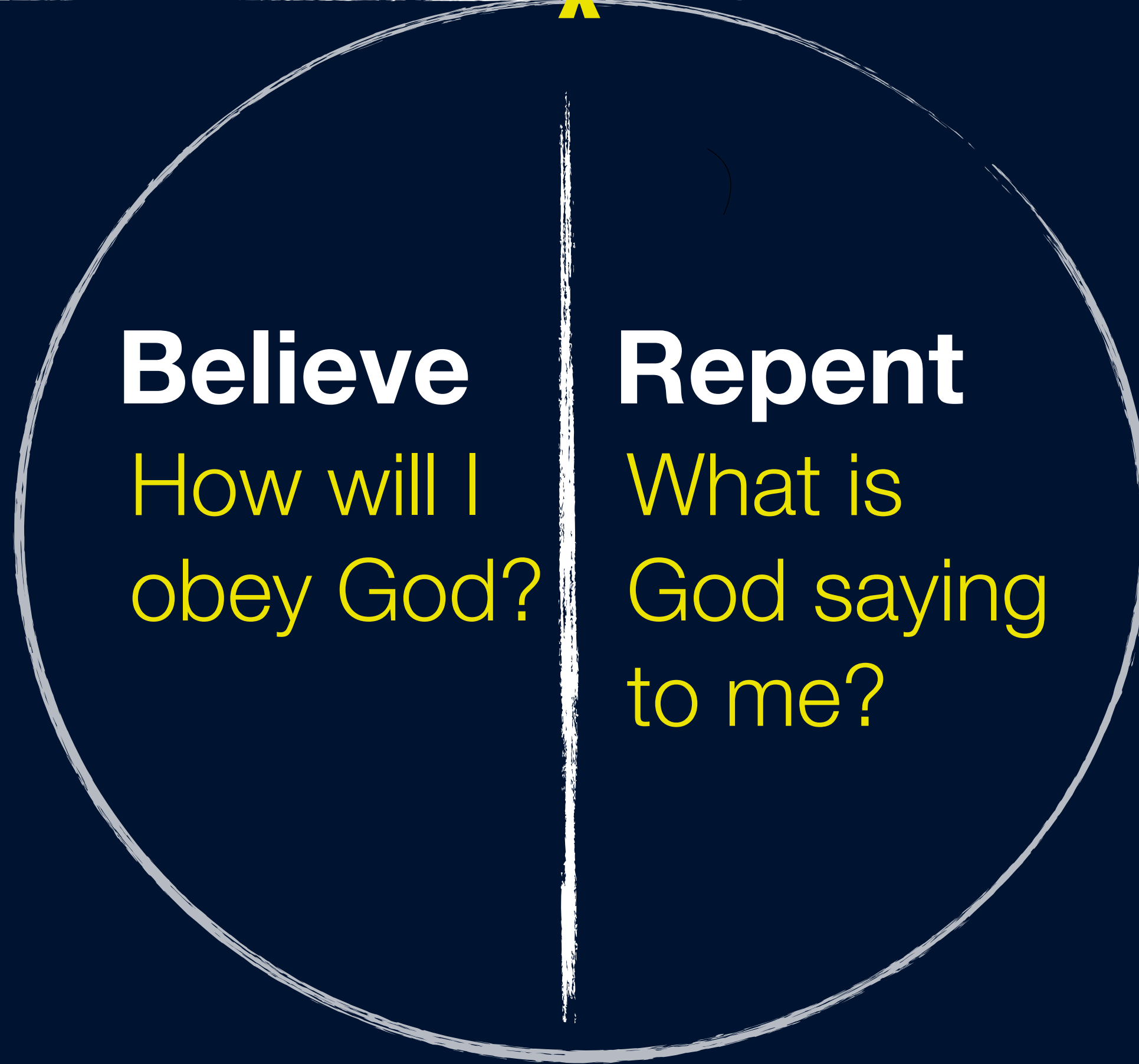
What is my SMART Goal or Action Step so that I am living in agreement with what God said to me?
