
1. Who does Jesus love? **Colossians 1:21 Ephesians 2:1, 12-13 1 Peter 4:3** Luke 15:2





Love accepts you where you are, but it won't let you stay there. People grow where they are loved and accepted.








In John 13, Jesus is creating a home where He can demonstrate radical love, inviting humanity to join Him in building "home" on the Earth.








2. How does Jesus love? John 13:4 - The posture of a slave. Luke 22:27 - Through serving, Jesus is giving them the Kingdom.
