Sealed in Victory - Freedom from the Enemy

- 1. Thanksgiving: Father, thank You that no accusation, temptation, or scheme can break the Spirit's seal.
- 2. <u>Intercession:</u> Pray for each other to live with the conviction to resist lies, stand against fear, and remain strong in victory.

Sealed in Fruitfulness - Living Fruitful Lives

- 1. Thanksgiving: King Jesus, thank you that when we abide in You, we bear fruits that last.
- 2. <u>Intercession:</u> Pray for each other's families, workplaces, and neighborhoods, wanting the fruit of the Spirit to overflow for the sake of the world.

Sealed in Joy - A Lifestyle of Repentance

- 1. Thanksgiving: Lord, thank You that repentance is not punishment, but the doorway to joy.
- 2. <u>Intercession:</u> Pray for each other to experience the joy in repenting quickly, joyfully, and repeatedly, to the God who forgives.
