A.They _____ Jesus and put a scarlet robe on Him – 27:28

28 And they stripped Him and put a scarlet robe on Him.

B.They twisted a _____ of thorns and placed it on His head. As if it were a kingly crown – 27:29a

29 When they had twisted a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand. And they bowed the knee before Him and mocked Him, saying, “Hail, King of the Jews!”

C.They put a _____ in His right hand. As if it were a king’s scepter – 27:29b

29 When they had twisted a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand. And they bowed the knee before Him and mocked Him, saying, “Hail, King of the Jews!”

D.They bowed the _____ before Him and mocked Him. As if He were a real king (little did they fully understand) – 27:29c

29 When they had twisted a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand. And they bowed the knee before Him and mocked Him, saying, “Hail, King of the Jews!”

E.They _____ on Him – 27:30

30 Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

F.They _____ Him with the reed – 27:30b

30 Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

G.They _____ Him – 27:31a

31 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.

H.They took the _____ off Him and put His own clothes on Him – 27:31b

31 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.

I. They _____ Him away to be crucified – 27:31c

31 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.

II. Jesus was _____ to a Cross and Mocked – 27:32-44

A.They _____ another (Simon) to carry Jesus’ cross – 27:32

32 Now as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name. Him they compelled to bear His cross.

B.They came to _____ (the place of the skull) – 27:33

33 And when they had come to a place called Golgotha, that is to say, Place of a Skull

C.They gave Him _____ wine mingled with gall to drink. When He tasted it, He would not drink – 27:34

34 they gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. But when He had tasted it, He would not drink.

D.They _____ Him – 27:35

35 Then they crucified Him, and divided His garments, casting lots, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet: “They divided My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots.”

E.They divided His _____ , casting lots (This also was a fulfillment of Prophecy) – 27:35b

35 Then they crucified Him, and divided His garments, casting lots, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet: “They divided My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots.”

F.They kept a _____ over Him – 27:36

36 Sitting down, they kept watch over Him there.

G. They put a _____ over His head which read: THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS – 27:37

37 And they put up over His head the accusation written against Him: THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS..

H.Two _____ were crucified alongside of Jesus – 27:38

38 Then two robbers were crucified with Him, one on the right and another on the left.

I. Everyone _____ Jesus while hanging on the cross – 27:39-44

39 And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads 40 and saying, “You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross.” 41 Likewise the chief priests also, mocking with the scribes and elders, said, 42 “He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him. 43 He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, ‘I am the Son of God.’ ” 44 Even the robbers who were crucified with Him reviled Him with the same thing.

Conclusion: All the abuse that Jesus faced He faced on our _____ – in our place.
