Who are our enemies?
The answer is:, we all have enemies. People who are antagonistic towards us. Those who despise what we stand for as Christians.
In verse 44, we discover practical towards loving one's enemies. Can I remind us that "love" is a verb which requires action. Jesus tells us how to "act" towards those who do not have our best interest in mind. Jesus taught,

The word "bless" means "to speak of." In other words, we are to speak well of those who do not speak well of us.
