In our text Jesus Christ is going to heal blind men.
I. Jesus heals the men – 9:27-31 In these verses before us we discover that Jesus is the great restorer! Jesus will restore the sight of two blind men.
A. Two blind men out to Jesus – 9:27 27 When Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, "Son of David, have mercy on us!"
What do we have in this verse?

The Faith of the Blind Men
Two Types of Blindness
First is blindness. The inability to see with the human eye. Second, there is blindness. The inability to see with the human
heart.
• In John 9, Jesus healed a man who was born blind from He testified, "I was blind. Now I see" (John 9:25).
 In John 3, Jesus heals a man who was spiritually blind, Nicodemus, a

religious man. Jesus said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one

is born again, he cannot **see** the kingdom of God" (John 3:3).

Matthew 12: 22-31 - 22 Then one was brought to Him who was demonpossessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man

both spoke and saw. ²³ And all the multitudes were amazed and said, "Could this be the Son of David?" ²⁴ Now when the Pharisees heard it they said, "This fellow does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons." ²⁵ But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: "Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand. ²⁶ If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his kingdom stand? ²⁷ And if I cast out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges. ²⁸ But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you. ²⁹ Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man? And then he will plunder his house. ³⁰ He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad. ³¹ "Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men. (Matthew 12:22-31).
