God Said It All

Genesis 1:1-31

Introduction: We begin our Summer 2026 Series today – **Six Days: God** _____ it.

I. In the _____ – 1:1-2

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

What do we have here in [Genesis 1:1](#)? Three facts:

1. We have the beginning of _____ - 1:1
2. We have the introduction of _____ – 1:1
3. We have the _____ of the heavens and the earth.

Everything we see was created and was not the result of some cosmic explosion, or random change. No, we are told clearly where everything came from – it was _____ by God.

Genesis 1:2 - *The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.*

God _____ the earth into existence, but it had no essence.

There are three words I want to focus on. They are “form, void, and darkness.”

This is straightforward darkness — the absence of _____, obscurity.

I. Then God _____ – (Days of Creation) 1:3-31

We are now going to turn our attention to God _____, filling, and lighting earth. And don't miss this, He did it all in six days!

Some people say – _____. It is, without God! ([Genesis 18:14](#); [Job 42:2](#); [Jeremiah 32:17](#); [Matthew 19:26](#); [Luke 1:37](#); [Ephesians 3:20](#)).

Day 1 - God said – Let there be _____ – 1:3-5

3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. 4 And God saw the light, that it was good; and God divided the light from the darkness. 5 God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day.

Day 2 - God said – "Let there be a _____ – 1:6-8

6 Then God said, "Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters." 7 Thus God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament; and it was so. 8 And God called the firmament Heaven. So the evening and the morning were the second day.

Day 3 - God said – "Let dry _____ appear." – 1:9-13

9 Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear"; and it was so. 10 And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering together of the waters He called Seas. And God saw that it was good. 11 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth"; and it was so. 12 And the earth brought forth grass, 13 So the evening and the morning were the third day.

Day 4 - God said – Let there be _____ in the firmament – 1:14-19

14 Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; 15 and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so. 16 Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. 17 God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, 18 and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. 19 So the evening and the morning were the fourth day.

Day 5 - God said – Let the water abound with an abundance of _____ creatures – 1:20-23

20 Then God said, “Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens.” 21 So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. 22 And God blessed them, saying, “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth.” 23 So the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

Day 6 - God said – Let the earth bring forth the living creatures according to its kind, and Let Us make _____ in Our image, and according to Our likeness – 1:24-31

24 Then God said, “Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind”; and it was so. 25 And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

II. God's _____ Creation – 1:26-27

1. God created _____ – 1:26-27

26 Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

2. God _____ Man – 1:28

28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

3. God _____ for His Creation – 1:29-31

29 And God said, “See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food.

Conclusion: Focus in on verse 31, *Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.*
