

DAY 6 – GOD IS PROVIDER

SCRIPTURE: PHILIPPIANS 4:19 DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT:

Paul doesn't say God might meet your needs. He says He will. Not according to your budget, your income, your ability, or your hustle—but according to His riches in glory. That's a different economy. Provision isn't just about money. God provides:

- Peace when your mind is loud
- Clarity when you're confused
- Strength when you're stretched
- Hope when life feels heavy
- People when loneliness tries to creep in
- Opportunities you didn't even know to ask for

Worry tells you, "It's all on you."
Provision reminds you, "It's all in God's hands."

And here's the thing: God doesn't just provide resources—He provides relationship. He doesn't want you to live stressed; He wants you to live supported. Revival grows in the heart that rests in God's faithfulness.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Where have you been worrying about lack or limitation?
- What would trusting God with that area practically look like?

PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS:

- **Thank God for one way He's provided** – even if it's small.
- **Name your biggest worry** out loud and surrender it.
- **Start a "provision journal"** for the next 21 days.
- **Give generously—even a small amount** – to remind your heart that God is your source.
