

DAY 21 – COMPLETE SURRENDER

SCRIPTURE: ROMANS 12:1

DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT:

Revival starts where surrender starts. Paul calls us to be “living sacrifices”—meaning daily, continual, wholehearted surrender. Not halfway. Not “God, You can have this but not that.”

Surrender isn't losing your life—it's finding the life God designed for you. When you give Him your fears, He gives you peace. When you give Him your plans, He gives you purpose. When you give Him your heart, He gives you His presence.

A fully surrendered heart is the soil where revival grows.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What area of your life is hardest to hand over to God?
- What would “ALL IN for Jesus” look like this year?

PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS:

- **Declare a surrender prayer:** “Lord, I’m all Yours.”
- **Identify one area** you’ve held back and give it to Him.
- **Commit to a next step:** baptism, serving, giving, or joining a C-Group.
- **Let someone know** what you’re surrendering for accountability.
