

DAY 10 – BOLD PRAYERS

SCRIPTURE: EPHESIANS 3:20 DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT:

If God can do more than we ask or imagine, then why do we pray so small? Bold prayers aren't about being dramatic—they're about believing God is as powerful as He says He is.

Sometimes we pray small because we've been disappointed. Sometimes we stop praying because we think God stopped listening. But bold prayers are an act of revival – they are your faith saying, "God, You're still able."

Bold prayers honor a big God.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What have you stopped praying for because it took too long?
- What bold prayer feels scary but necessary?

PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS:

- **Write ONE big, bold prayer** and circle it every day this week.
- **Share your bold prayer** with someone who will pray with you.
- **Pray out loud**—your faith grows when your mouth leads.
- **Expect God to move**, not because you're good, but because He's faithful. healing.
