

DAY 15 – FAITH OVER FEAR

SCRIPTURE: 2 TIMOTHY 1:7

DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT:

Fear is loud—but faith is stronger. Fear imagines the worst. Faith expects God's best. Fear paralyzes. Faith mobilizes.

God has not given you a spirit of fear, so if fear is speaking loudly, it's not coming from Him. Revival replaces a fearful heart with a courageous one.

Courage isn't the absence of fear—it's choosing God in the presence of fear.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What fear has been trying to control your thoughts or decisions?
- What would acting in faith look like instead?

PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS:

- **Write down the fear**—then cross it out and replace it with a promise.
- **Say the promise out loud** every morning.
- **Take one small step of courage** today.
- **Share your fear** with someone who can stand in faith with you.

Lord, silence every fear that's been speaking to me. Fill my heart with boldness, courage, and faith. Help me see situations through Your power, not my limitations. Strengthen me today. Amen.
