SCRIPTURE: 1 THESSALONIANS 5:18

DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT:

Gratitude is a spiritual weapon. It shifts your focus from what's missing to what's already present. It turns your attention from what you can't control to the God who can.

A grateful heart is a revived heart because gratitude is worship disguised as perspective. It quiets anxiety and shrinks bitterness. You can't always change your situation, but you can always change your spirit within it.
