

Reflecting on Acts 28

Discussion Questions | November 27, 2022

1. **Read Acts 28:1-16.** Paul interacts with several unbelievers in these verses. Describe how Paul built credibility within these groups, and how he effectively used these relationships to share the gospel.

2. **Read Acts 28:16.** In this verse, Paul lands in Rome and God's promise to him is fulfilled (see Acts 23:11; 27:24). How does Paul's arrival in Rome also effectively accomplish Jesus's words in Acts 1:8?

3. **Read Acts 28:30-31.** Think back over the entire book of Acts. What obstacles did believers in the early church overcome to witness Christ to the ends of the earth? What are some challenges you have faced as you share the gospel?

4. **Read Acts 2:42.** At the beginning of our series, we considered these ministry priorities of the early church: devotion to teaching, fellowship, hospitality, and prayer. How have you seen these characteristics demonstrated throughout the book of Acts? What are some ways we can emphasize these commitments in our own church life?

5. **Consider Acts 1-28.** What is your biggest takeaway from the "Lessons from the Book of Acts" study?
