7) **Read Luke 15:25-32.** What sin does the older brother commit in this parable? How is the response of the older brother similar to how the Pharisees treated Jesus?

8) Summarize the main thought of these parables in your own words.

Reflecting on "Lost & Found— The Parables of the Sheep, Coin, and Sons" Luke 15 | March 10, 2024

Discussion Questions

1) **Read Luke 15:1-3.** This passage opens with an interesting problem: As the "tax collectors and sinners" draw near to listen to Jesus, the religious elite complain because Jesus actually welcomes the outcasts of society.

If we are to truly learn the lesson of these parables, we need to ask ourselves, "What types of people might we struggle to welcome into our church?"

After honestly assessing your heart, respectfully discuss why you might struggle to worship standing alongside certain types of people.

2) At a fundamental level, what do the scribes and Pharisees have in common with the thieves and sinners they sought to distance themselves from?

3) **Read Luke 15:4-7 and Luke 19:1-10.** The latter passage tells the story of how a real tax collector repented of his sin. Describe biblical repentance based on the example of Zacchaeus.

4) **Read Luke 15:6-7, 9-10.** In each of these parables, there is a celebration after that which was lost is found. Jesus tells us these occasions picture the "joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." What are some things that bring you the level of joy expressed by the shepherd and woman? How much does the gospel excite you?

5) **Read Luke 15:11-32.** If these parables illustrate God's pursuit of sinners, what does the parable of the two sons teach us about God's work through the circumstances of our lives?

6) **Read Luke 15:11-24.** Describe the love of the father in this parable. What, if any, of his actions surprise you? How does this father emulate the love of God?
