Series Preface

As evidenced by the title above, our resource for the next three weeks of Sunday School contrasts the true Gospel (Christ Alone) with other popular, but unbiblical teaching, including the Prosperity Gospel. As we prepare for this first session, we encourage you to consider two general questions:

1) What is the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

2) What is not the Gospel, or what is a false gospel?

Below are some more specific questions to help you form your answers:

3) Do you believe there is a difference between the Gospel and morality? If so, how would you explain the difference? Some preachers have said, "Deep down, most people are good inside; they just do bad things." Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Explain your answer. 4) What does it mean to be good by God's standard (i.e., according to the Bible)?

5) If the Bible is correct and ALL PEOPLE are sinners, incapable of goodness and righteousness on their own, how is the Gospel a message of hope?

6) Do people ever "graduate" from the Gospel? In other words, do you think Christians need to hear the Gospel, or is the Good News only for unbelievers? Explain your answer.
