



## Weeks Eleven & Twelve Family Discussion Questions

(August 15-28)

**In our final studies, we learn how Jesus fulfills God's promise to rescue sinful people like you and me.**

1. Read Matthew 27:51-54 and Luke 23:44-47.

- What is significant about the curtain in the temple tearing in half? How does this event prove that Jesus is the one Messiah who can restore man's broken relationship with God?
- What do the centurion's words tell us about Jesus? In particular, how do they reveal that **only** Jesus can save people from their sin?

2. How did the disciples of Jesus respond when they learned that their Savior was alive? How does Jesus' death **and** resurrection make a difference in your life?

3. What are some ways that you can obey Jesus' commands to his followers in Matthew 28:18-20? Finally, what promises are contained in these verses?
  
4. Toward the end of the book, "The Promise" there are two summary pages that outline how Jesus is, "unlike any other man or woman who came before." Talk through these pages with your family, and see if you can explain what makes Jesus perfectly fit to be our promised Messiah.
  
5. What have you learned about Jesus through this study? What have you learned about yourself?
