


10 WAYS TO PRAY FOR THE AIYEGBUSI FAMILY IN NIGERIA



1. PRAY FOR A SPIRITUAL AWAKENING:

Pray that the “Lord of the Harvest” (Matt 9:37-38) would precede us into the city of Jos and plow the hearts of lost people, readying them for the Gospel. Pray that through our house churches, God would bring about a spiritual awakening starting in the city of Jos and spreading into the northern parts of Nigeria. Pray that as a result of our house churches, God would spiritually energize the young men and women in the city with an evangelistic fervor and mobilize them to live out the great commission.

2. PRAY FOR MUSLIMS IN THE NORTH:

Pray that the persecuted Christians in Islamized northern states will be characterized by a spirit of love and forgiveness, and that that the systemic, institutionalized, and direct persecution of Christians would cease abruptly. In the same breath, pray also that through an incredible move of God and the witness of the Church, northern Muslims

would embrace Jesus Christ as the LORD and Savior of their lives.

3. PRAY AGAINST SPIRITUAL ATTACKS:

We recognize that our ministry push into the city of Jos is a battle, “...not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.” So, pray that God would break the spiritual strongholds the enemy has over the city of Jos, whatever they may be. Pray that *we* would be delivered from every scheme and attack of the devil and that the angels of God would surround us like a wall of fire as they did with the prophet Elisha in 2 Kings 6:17.

4. PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH PLANS:

In Titus 1:5, Paul writes to the young pastor, “The reason I left you in Crete was that you might put in order what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you.” Pray that God would help us identify five godly men to serve as elders and oversee our house churches, men who fit the godly qualifications mentioned in the scriptures. Pray also that God would also help us raise up other godly creative team members to serve in the different ministry areas we will need.

5. PRAY FOR SAFE TRAVEL:

We have several stops on our way before we arrive at our final home destination in Jos. Pray that the airports remain open and we stay free from covid-19 during our travels. Pray for our 12-hour layover with the kids in London. Pray for our week-and-a-half quarantine in the capital city in Abuja, and for God's traveling mercies as we finally cross state lines to our home in the city of Jos. Pray for the safe and timely arrival of our shipping container to our home in Jos, and for everything in it to be safely intact the way we packed it.

6. PRAY FOR LANGUAGE LEARNING:

Pray that we would find a skilled Hausa language teacher in Jos and our family would pick up the Hausa language pretty quickly so that we're able to have fluent conversations with the northern locals.

7. PRAY FOR OUR CHILDREN:

Our calling to Nigeria is every bit about our kids as much as it is about us as parents. Pray that our transition to Nigeria would result in one of the greatest adventures our children will recall ever having experienced. Pray that *they* would easily make friends in Jos and joyfully acclimate to the new culture. Pray that their faith in and love for Jesus would grow stronger as a result of our decision to serve God in Nigeria.

8. PRAY FOR OUR MARRIAGE + FRIENDSHIPS:

Pray for close intimacy for Dupe and I so that even in the busy preparation and settling-in process, our marriage remains strong. Pray also that God would bless Dupe and I with close friends we can do life with and be accountable to.

9. PRAY FOR BOLDNESS AND COURAGE:

In light of the history of inter-ethnic violence and Christian persecution that have taken place in Jos, pray that God would fill us with boldness to proclaim the Gospel fearlessly and the courage to lead His church starting in Jos and spreading throughout northern Nigeria. As in Hebrew 13:6, pray that we can "... confidently say, "The Lord is [our] helper; [we] will not fear; what can man do to [us]?"

10. PRAY FOR OUR FUNDING:

We will be able to maximize the fruitfulness of our family and ministry in Nigeria because people like you not only pray for us, but also support us financially. Pray that we will continue to experience God's generosity from God's people, and that we will be blessed to reach all our ministry and personal financial support goals.
