SPEAKING THE WORD OF GOD OVER YOUR FAMILY

TEXT: PSALM 127-128

It's not possible to be spiritually mature while remaining emotionally immature. We must be both spiritually and emotionally healthy for our families.

Proverbs 18

Psalms 127 - 128

Say to them: ““The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.”’ “So they will put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them.”
