*Descendants of Abraham
that split from David's line
after King Solomon
(1 Kings 12)*

*Called themselves "true
keepers of the Torah"
(Genesis-Deuteronomy)*

*Worshiped at a temple on
Mount Gerizim because of
commands in Deuteronomy*

Jews were:

*Descendants of Abraham
that followed David's line
when the kingdom split
(waiting on the Messiah)*

*Based their beliefs off the
whole Old Testament*

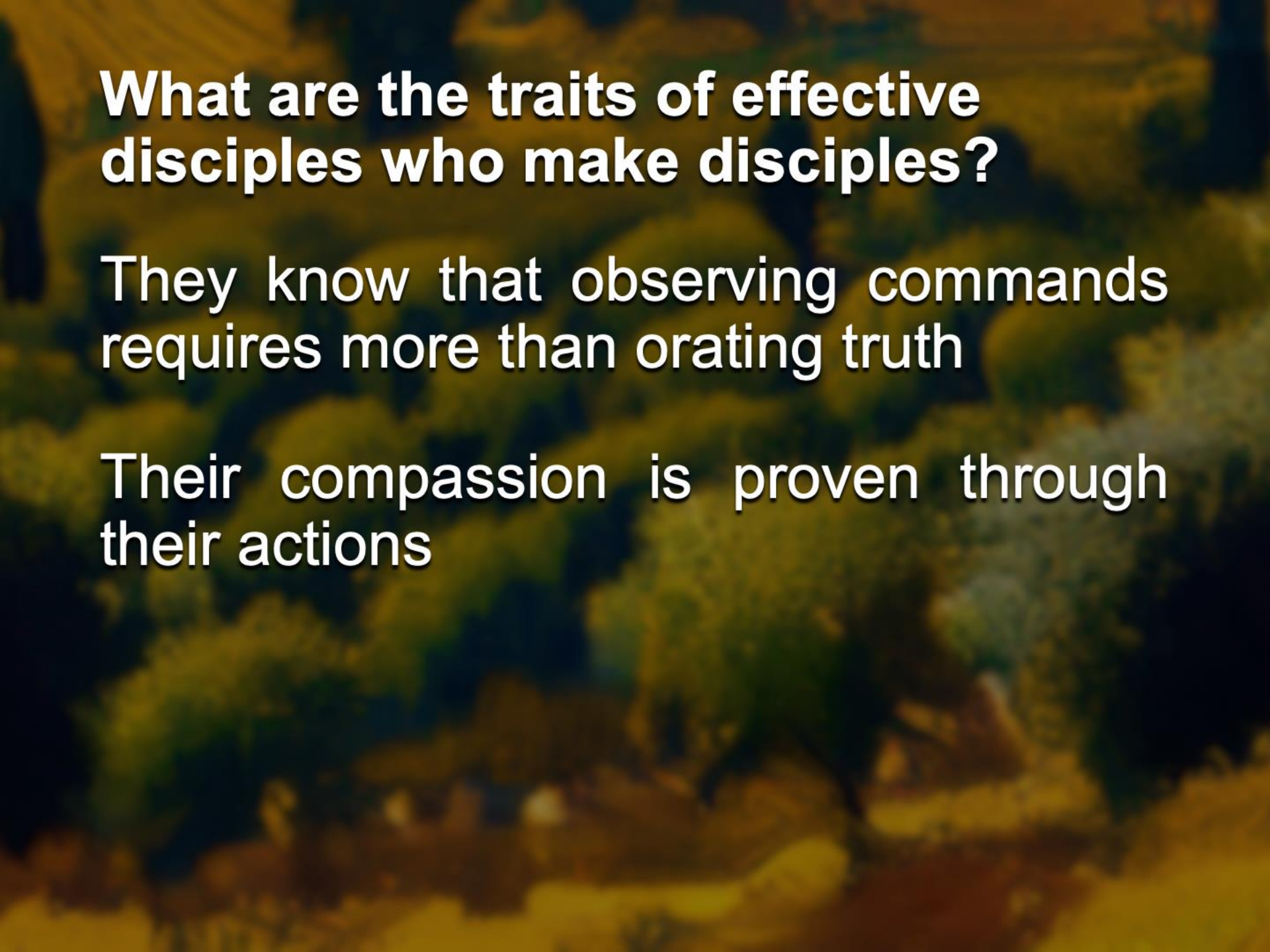
*Worshiped at the temple in
Jerusalem*

But **a Samaritan**, as he journeyed, came to where he was, and **when he saw him, he had compassion. He went to him** and bound up his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he set him on his own animal and brought him to an inn and took care of him.
