Gigi Marvin

- 1. Gigi spoke about the temptation to focus on our goals/dreams and see those around us as our 'competition'. What does the Bible say about how we are to view others? *Philippians 2:3-4; Proverbs 24:17; Romans 12:10*
- 2. Through her experience at the Olympics in Russia, Gigi realized that God not only sent her there to play hockey but to also teach her something. God uses the events and people in our lives to guide and instruct us as we grow in our faith, but we have to be willing to give it all to God and allow Him to work within our lives. What have you gone through, or are currently going through, that you need to turn over to God so that He can use it for good and can deepen your relationship with Him?

- 3. Lisa Marie explained that when we vocalize our negative thoughts and frustrations that we are prophesying over our lives; i.e. I'm overwhelmed, I'm tired, this is too much, I'm never good enough, etc. What can we experience when we shift our focus onto God and speak His Truths? *Psalms 16:7-9, 11; 1 Chronicles 16:27; 2 Corinthians 6:16*
- 4. Lisa Marie stated that there are 3 truths that we must accept to be in agreement with God and usher in His presence: 1) God is altogether good. 2) He loves us. 3) We can trust Him. Satan wants to trick us into doubting these truths because if we agree with Satan (the flesh), then we usher in the presence of sin. What agreement was made that ushered sin into this world? *Genesis 3:1-6; Romans 5:12*
