### • Stop Making Excuses

### • Get Back Into the Game

When our focus is not on God we tend to panic, pout and pull out. God has a plan and purpose for your life. Now it is up to you to see it through. What intentional steps will you take to put your focus back on God?

## • Depend on God.

"God won't ask you to do anything He hasn't given you the power to do." It's a matter of obedience, not convenience. In what ways will you demonstrate complete trust and dependence on God in 2015?
