1. Honesty

We are never alone. God and Satan are always watching. Every moment is an opportunity to lead a life of honesty. If you died today, what would you be remembered for? What do you want to be remembered for? What can you do to make sure they match?

2. Dependability

Dependability promotes stability. We all desire stability and want to have people in our lives we can count on; but we must first become that which we desire. What does being dependable look like? What changes can you make in your life to become someone others can count on?

3. Godliness

The difference between success and *true* success is having eternity in mind. People are naturally drawn to people who put God first. Just like the Apollo astronauts needed Mission Control to stay the course, we need God to guide us. How will you make God number one in your life and seek Him daily?
