If our hearts desire is to leave a lasting legacy, the landscape of our legacy should include the following:

OUR COMPASSION

How are we more like Christ when we are filled with compassion for others? What does it mean to forgive someone "seventy-seven times" or "seventy times seven"? Are things like mercy and grace easily identified in your Christian walk?

OUR DESIRE

How should having Christ in our heart change our desires? Because Jesus "came to serve and give his life for many", what should be our desire(s)? How do we as Christians overcome temptation and sin in our lives?

Mark 8:34-38: Mark 10:42-45: Galatians 5:24

OUR HEART ATTITUDE

How does our heart attitude determine our actions? What is the blessing of being pure in heart? How can we remain clean in our hearts?

Matthew 5:8; Mark 7:19-21; Mark 12:29-31

Where does the strength and ability to leave a legacy by living like this come from? *Colossians 1:27; Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 12:9*
