Four Reasons WHY People Pleasing is a DEADLY TRAP:

1: You'll MISS God's PLAN(S) FOR YOUR LIFE.

Why is it essential to filter people's opinions through God's Word?

Proverbs 14:12; Galatians 1:10; 1 Thessalonians 2:4

2: You CANNOT grow SPIRITUALLY.

How does allowing people to have more influence on you than God's word stop your spiritual growth?

John 5:44; Matthew 15:8-9

3: It LEADS To SIN.

How can wanting to fit in with people who don't know Christ, or even with Christians not living for Christ, cause us to sin?

1 Corinthians 15:33; Proverbs 22:24-25; Proverbs 1:10

4: It KILLS my WITNESS.

Discuss how being people pleasers can make us afraid to share Jesus to non-Christians or challenge Christians who may not be serving Christ.

John 7:9-13; John 12:42-43; Romans 12:2; Isaiah 51:12

- **God DIDN'T.** God is not a people pleaser.
- **You WON'T.** It's impossible to please everyone.
- **He CAN.** You already have God's approval through what Jesus has done for you.

- Make a quality decision to please God regardless of what people think of you.
- Study His Word as only His Truth will set you free.
- Guard you relationships with people that may tempt you to fall into sin.
- As you become free, help people get to know His Truth that will set them free as well.
