## **1.** *Life is a fast trip.*

A man's life expectancy is 76 years and a woman's is 81 years. Even though that may seem like a long time, discuss what our mind set should be according to God's Word.

## 2. God has a directive will and a permissive will.

Even though God is ultimately in control of this world, discuss how He has given mankind the ability to make the choice whether to obey Him or rebel against Him and the generational ramifications.

Deuteronomy 6:1-15, Deuteronomy 30:19, Proverbs 6:20-23

## **3.** The Bible is all about God's covenant with us.

Even though God is slow to anger and forgives us when we repent, discuss how the sins of one generation can affect our society for many generations to follow. Numbers 14:18, Exodus 34:6-7

4. Now that we've accepted Jesus as our Lord and Savior, discuss how He made us free to share His love with the lost regardless of how we were raised or the parenting mistakes we have made.

Galatians 3:13-14, Philippians 3:12-14, Luke 15:4
