Guard your heart above all else for it determines the course of our lives. Proverbs 4:23.

Discuss three ways in which our heart is revealed.

- Discuss how our <u>words</u> reveal what's in our hearts and some adjustments we may need to make in the way we speak. What are ways or words that we can use to build each other up as we try to become more like Christ? Luke 6:43-45; James 3:5-10; Proverbs 4:24
- How does what we look at with our <u>eyes</u> determine our character? Are there areas in your life where you might be serving two masters? How has God blessed your life in taking ownership of these areas? Matthew 6:22-23; Matthew 13:14-16; 2 Peter 2:14
- 3. How do our <u>feet</u> (actions) determine who we really are? In what ways has God been using you as a servant? How have you been blessed by being able to do so? James 1:21-25; James 2:14-20; 1 John 3:18
