Emille gave her testimony of how God is working out His plan for her life. *Ecclesiastes 3:11* in the Amplified Bible says "God has also planted eternity (a sense of divine purpose) in the human heart (a mysterious longing which nothing under the sun can satisfy except God). That's why people try to fill that hole in their hearts with money, relationships, alcohol and drugs, among other things. While we can't know everything about God's plans, *Deuteronomy 29:29* tells us there are secret things that belong only to God, but the things He wants us to know He will reveal to us and to our children forever.

Is it really possible to know God's will for our lives? Share what God has shown you to be His will for your life.

1 Corinthians 2:12; Ephesians 1:9-11; Ephesians 5:17

According to Jesus and the apostle Paul, who teaches us God's will? *John 7: 16-17; John 14:16-17, 26: John 16:13; 1 Corinthians 2:13*

Discuss how the Holy Spirit teaches us the will of God.

Hebrews 10:15-17; Hebrews 8:10; Romans 12:2

Romans 12:2 says there is a good, acceptable and perfect will of God. While we may never completely know God's perfect will for our lives, discuss some things that we know are of God's will.

John 14:15; John 15:12; 1 Thessalonians 5:18

There are many things that we know are God's will. As we are faithful to obey the things we know are God's will, He shows us more of Himself and His will for our lives. *John 14:21*

- Listen to the Holy Spirit and let Him teach you God's Word.
- Let the Holy Spirit lead and guide you rather than being led by feelings.
- Choose to obey the things you KNOW are God's will.
- Trust God that you're on the path to living out His Divine plan for your life.
