Identity determines everything

Every failure in our lives happens because we allow our identity to be stolen. God told David in *1 Samuel 30:8* he needed to fight for what's important, and so do we. Discuss some things you believe are worth fighting for.

Keith taught about three things every Christian should pursue.

-A church that's radical. Acts 26:19-20
-A church that's righteous. Proverbs 23:19
-A church that's reconciled.
2 Corinthians 5:18

Of those three things, which is the hardest for you to pursue?

There are two things every Christian must decide.

1. Define your relationship with Jesus.

On a scale of 1-10 (1 being far from Christ, 10 being fully devoted to Christ), where are you right now? Why? How should your life change when you get saved?

Ephesians 2:8-10; 1 Peter 2:1-2; Galatians 5:19-24

2. Determine your commitment.

Discuss what Jesus said A Christian's commitment should look like. Does His definition of commitment match yours? What is one thing you can do to make sure the definitions are the same? *Matthew 16:24-27; John 15:12-13; Revelation 3:15-16,19.*
