

Calvary Chapel of Anne Arundel County Church Services Guide (as of June 4, 2020)

8:30am & 6pm – Bible Study

- Livestreamed over the web Only
- This is our usual full-length verse-by-verse Bible Study.

10:00am – Worship & the Word

- Outdoor Service, livestream over the web, and livestream through the church building.
- This is a mixture of Worship & a Short Bible Devotion (approximately 50 minutes long)
- Children’s Church will be in a separate area (at this time Elementary School & Middle School only).
- **Car Section Parking**
 - For those who want to stay in car (car engine cannot be running due to exhaust gases)
 - 6-foot physical distancing between families required (parking within the lines not required).
- **Outdoor Main Seating (sitting on the hill or chairs on pavement)**
 - Car Section (as described above)
 - @Risk Section - For those who are @risk and/or are caretakers for those @risk. This section will be 6-foot physical distancing, no physical contact, no food or drink, and masks worn at all times.
 - No Mask Section – For those who choose not to wear a mask. Per CDC 6-foot physical distancing still required. Masks are optional.
 - ADA Section – For those with special needs or circumstances who may benefit from a 12-foot physical distancing. Masks are optional.
- **Coffee House Seating / Infant Room / Zoe Life Room**
 - Service will be livestreamed throughout the building.
 - Seating for families with children who are not participating in Children’s Church, or have infants, toddlers, and preschool age children.
 - For the safety of the child they will be inside the building away from moving cars. Also, there is a sound level we cannot exceed per County code, and therefore we cannot amplify sound over crying babies. And... the building has air-conditioning, and immediate access to restrooms.
 - Everyone over the age of 2 must wear a mask. Physical distancing of 6-foot is required at all times between families.
- **Sanctuary Seating**
 - Service will be livestreamed into the sanctuary.
 - *Special Needs* - There will be seating for those with special needs or ADA (Mask are recommended but not required for this section), Physical distancing of 6-foot is required. If possible, please wear a mask to/from car.
 - *Adults* - There will be seating for adults (high school and above) who choose not to sit outside for whatever reason. Masks and 6-foot physical distancing required at all times.
 - Entry/Exit into the sanctuary can be through the outside door of the sanctuary, so to avoid walking through the narrow hallways. Please wear a mask to/from your car to protect others.
- **Children’s Church**
 - Please note, children’s church is not required, but only if parent feels comfortable sending their child to participate in children’s church.
 - Depending on the ground condition, we will either have the children's church over the hill in the field, or we will have it in the back of the church. In either case, there will be signs that will be pointing towards which direction the children's church is.
 - Children are expected to wear their mask at all times and keep a 6-foot physical distance from all non-family members. Parents please ensure your child has his/her mask before leaving home.
 - All teachers will be wearing masks at all times.
 - We will have a kids-check-in. Your phone number will be required.
 - Due to safety and security reasons for the protection of the child, any child in the children's church that needs to go to the restroom, their parent will be contacted via a text on their cell

phone to come get them and take them. The parent is expected wiped down all touch areas with the Clorox wipes before/after use (gloves and wipes will be provided).

- For any other questions regarding Children's Church please contact Steve/Taz or the Church.

- **Restroom uses inside the Church**

- Masks must be worn when in bathroom and walking to the bathroom (our bathrooms and especially the hallway are extremely small/narrow and physical distancing is not possible).
- Only 1 person (or family) allowed in bathroom at a time. Please knock before entering the restroom.
- Please remember the outdoor service is still a time of reverence and fellowship with the Lord, so please be mindful of being a distraction to others.

Miscellaneous Information regarding the Sunday Services

- **If you find yourself in some type of circumstance that is not addressed here, please call or email the church to let us know what it is, and we will discuss how to meet your need.**
- If weather does not permit the outdoor service, an announcement will be made on the Saturday night prior at 6pm on our website. Both the 8:30am, 10:00am, and 6pm service will be livestream only.
- If you are sick or someone in your home is sick, please stay home all, and watch via the livestream.
- If you see someone wearing a mask and you want to talk to them, please wear a mask, and physical distance from them at 6-foot. If they are wearing a mask assume they are an @risk person or are caretakers for those whose are @risk.
- Due to the limitations that come with Facebook, we will be singing older hymns and worship songs.
- Remember/recommend wearing sunscreen, tick spray, and blankets to sit on.
- The offering box will not be out until further notice. Please use the postal mail or the online giving portal.
- Communion elements will be available at the church, and if you choose to use them, hand sanitizing should be practiced. Please take the used elements with you upon leaving. If you are sitting in the @risk section, please do virtual communion which is to not take your mask off so to protect all around you.
- The Coffee Table will not be available at this time.
- Please no vaping or smoking within 100 feet of the building or sitting area.
- Please bring your own Bible; shared Bibles will not be available at this time.
- Bring your own water. The water fountain inside the church is not allowed for use per the County.
- The building will be closed and locked at 11:30am; however, people are free to fellowship outside the facility after the service is over as long as they so desire.
- The service will be live streamed starting at 10:00 AM, take the opportunity to invite friends and family to join us and experience the excitement of doing church together again.
- There is always a possibility that news reporters or community neighbors could show up because of the uniqueness of outdoor services in this unprecedented time. Let's not give anyone an opportunity to make an accusation and lay a charge against the church. Let them see that we respect the community and each other and observe the laws of the land.
- We understand that not everyone is comfortable with coming out to the indoor or outdoor service at this time, and we do not want you to be put in a position that you're not comfortable with. So please know and understand that we fully support your decision not to come and encourage you to watch via the live.
- If you would like to help out and serve in the various ministries, please contact the church.

The Other Services Information

- The 7pm Tuesday Night Prayer will continue as livestream only until further notice.
- The 10am Thursday Woman's Fellowship will be livestreamed, and on-site. Masks must be worn at all times (from car exit – to car entry), and 6-foot physical distancing required. There will be ADA seating.
- The 7pm Thursday Night Bible Study will continue as livestream only until further notice.
- The Saturday Men's Fellowship will be on-site only. Masks must be worn at all times (from car exit – to car entry), and 6-foot physical distancing required. There will be ADA seating.
- The Friday Night Young Adults will be Zoom meeting only until further notice.
- The 4pm Saturday Youth Group will be on-site. Masks must be worn at all times (from car exit – to car entry), and 6-foot Physical distancing required. ADA will be accommodated. The mid-week will be Zoom.
