ETERNAL MAJESTY. READ PHILIPPIANS 2:5-6.

- What does it mean that Jesus was in the "form of God"?
- How does this shape our understanding of His eternal majesty?

PERFECT HUMILITY. READ PHILIPPIANS 2:7-8.

- What does it mean that Jesus "emptied Himself"?
- Discuss a time when you had to set aside your own privileges or rights for the sake of others. How did it feel, and what did you learn?

DIVINE TRAGEDY. READ PHILIPPIANS 2:8

- Why is it important to understand the depth of Jesus' sacrifice?
- How does acknowledging our own sinfulness and need for a Savior change the way we view the cross?

TRIUMPHANT VICTORY. READ PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11

- What does it mean for Jesus to be exalted and given the name above every name?
- How does the resurrection of Jesus provide hope and assurance in your life?

DIVINE TRAGEDY.

- Discuss the significance of Jesus' return as described in the Nicene Creed. How does this future hope influence your present actions and decisions?
- In what ways can we proclaim Christ's sovereignty in our communities and relationships?

THE CREED Week 4 Discussion Questions

DIGGING DEEPER.

- **Reflect on all the Nicene Creed's statements about Jesus.** How do these ancient affirmations help us guard against modern misunderstandings of who Jesus is?
- Consider the implications of Jesus' dual nature as fully God and fully man. How does this mystery enhance your worship and understanding of the gospel?
- Identify specific areas in your life where you can model Christ's humility. What steps can you take this week to serve others selflessly?
