Key Scriptures

"If your right eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell."

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- One reason hell exists is for God to righteously punish Satan, who is the embodiment of all evil. Talk about any area of your life that the enemy might be trying to steal, kill, or destroy.
- God is holy and just, which means He must punish sin. How can you find freedom from sin and hope in Jesus today?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, we are so thankful for the abundant grace, mercy, and love You've shown us through Jesus. We know hell exists because You need to punish Satan and evil. Please use us to help others know You and experience Your perfect love. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
