3. God promises to meet our needs but not necessarily our wants. Why is that?
4. How does understanding God from the perspective of a sheep and a good shepherd help me become a person after God's own heart?
5. Why don't I rest well? Is it tied to my desire to fuel my identity?
6. Why is it critical for obedience to the Good Shepherd to start with love for Him?
