MAIN POINTS & KEY SCRIPTURES

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. When someone gives you a greeting card or a letter, are you in the habit of saving them? If so, what does that say about the letter or person who wrote it?
- 2. Do you have any questions about the Bible (like when it was written, how to read it, etc.)? What could you do to get those questions answered?
- 3. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. Verse 16 says that all Scripture is "God breathed". If someone asked you how you know the Scriptures are God's Word, what would you say?
- 4. Read Psalm 119:105. In what way does God's word illuminate?
- 5. Read Psalm 119:11. Why should we commit Scripture to memory?
- 6. Is there an area in your life or a decision with which you're currently struggling? Share it with the group and ask them if any Scriptures or Biblical principles can help you make this decision. In addition, pray about it and ask God to reveal the truth from His word.

GOING FURTHER

MEMORIZE: All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 ESV

READ: Psalm 119 is all about God's word. It is arranged in 22 8-verse sections. Over the next 22 days, read a section each day and meditate on it for 10 minutes.
