# **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. When you were young, who had the most power over your behavior? Why were they so influential, either positively or negatively?
- 2. **Read Acts 18:24-26.** Aquila and Priscilla played a significant role in the early church Christians mentioned in the book of Acts. What approach did Priscilla and Aquila take to instruct Apollos and help him grow? When have you take the time to help correct or instruct another Christian, or when did someone do that for you? How did their approach (or yours) impact their receptivity? (See also Ephesians 4:15 & 4:29.)
- 3. Read Acts 19:1-6. Whose disciples were these people? What is the difference between John's baptism and Christian baptism (see vs 4)?
- 4. Read Acts 19:6. How did the believers in Acts 19 know that they had received the Holy Spirit? What are some of the ways believers can know today? (See also Acts 2:38, Ephesians 1:13-14, Romans 8:5-14, Galatians 5:13-26, and 1 John 3:24.)
- 5. **Read Romans 8:5-14.** What characterizes a person who lives according to the flesh versus according to the Spirit? Why is knowing the constant presence of God's Spirit a powerful deterrent to giving in to the temptations that come with our struggle with sin? How does the Spirit help us fight our battles? Give an example.
- 6. Read Acts 19:4-7 & 1 John 3:24. How does their eagerness to be baptized reveal their faith and the work of the Spirit in them? Do you have a similar eagerness to embrace and obey God's Word in your life when you encounter it? Why or why not?
- 7. If someone asked you why someone should be baptized, what would you say? Should someone wait a certain length of time before they are baptized?
