TALK IT OVER

Spend a few minutes discussing the sermon from the weekend. Was there anything new that you learned, anything that confused you or anything that stood out?

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. Have one or two people in your group look up examples of kintsugi to share. What do these renewed objects make you think or feel about the object itself or the person who made it?
- 2. Read Acts 2:22-23. What does it make you feel to know that God is not ignoring or minimizing the wreckage in our lives, but is instead including it in His plan?
- 3. **Read Ephesians 2:8-9.** When did you first understand that salvation was not something to be worked for, but was a gift from God? How does the truth that salvation is by grace change the way we think about religious actions?
- 4. Read 1 Timothy 1:12-17. Our testimonies are powerful when they display God's work of redeeming and restoring the broken pieces of our lives. In which specific ways has God redeemed broken pieces of your life?
- 5. Read Romans 8:1-5. If you were the coach of a team devoted to living life in the Spirit, what would your team practices look like? What principles would you encourage your team to set their minds on?
- 6. Read Ephesians 2:10. Holiness is not just refraining from sin but being proactive to walk in holiness. What can you do with the rest of this day, this week, and this month to actively walk in holiness?

GOING FURTHER

MEMORIZE: For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10
