GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. What is a song or band that captures the culture or time that you grew up? What values did the song or band exemplify?
- 2. In Exodus 15 one of the first reasons Moses mentions we should worship God is for what He has done. What are some things God has done in your life for which you can thank Him?
- 3. One of the Jesus' most significant acts was his sacrificial death and resurrection. What did they secure for us or accomplish on our behalf? See Romans 6:6-7, Ephesians 2:14-16, Colossians 2:13-15 and 1 Peter 1:3-5.
- 4. **Read Exodus 15:3-13.** Which characteristics of God did Moses mention in his song? What do you think the significance was of choosing those characteristics over others?
- 5. Which attribute of God most amazes you, and why? *If you have trouble coming up with one, spend a few minutes in a group brainstorm naming some.*
- 6. **Read Exodus 15:13-18.** Moses says the third reason we should worship God is what He *will* do. What are some promises God gave to Moses? What are some things He has promised to do in the future? *See 2 Peter 3:13, 1 Corinthians 15:54-57, Revelation 7:9.*
- 7. Of the three reasons why we should worship God (what He has done, who He is, and what He will do), which do you think about most often? What could you intentionally do to remember all three of these reasons more often?
