### **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. Have you ever been caught off guard by unknowingly offending someone you care about? Was your initial internal response different from the ultimate way you responded?
- 2. Read Numbers 5:6-7 & Luke 19:8-9. In the story of Zacchaeus, we see a practical demonstration of repentance involving restitution. How can making amends, like Zacchaeus did, contribute to genuine reconciliation?
- 3. Read Matthew 5:23. In this passage, Jesus emphasizes the importance of reconciliation before offering a gift to God. How does this illustrate the priority of human relationships in God's eyes?
- 4. What are some examples of Christ of extending forgiveness to those who wronged him or accused him? *See Luke 23:34, Luke 22:61-62, John 21:15-19, Matthew 26:47-56.*
- 5. How can you proactively resolve conflict with a non-believer so your humility and love will point them to Christ? *See Romans 5:6-8 and Matthew 6:12.*
- 6. Share a personal experience where confronting and resolving an offense led to healing in a relationship. How did it impact you and the other person?
- 7. Think about a current or past relationship where reconciliation is needed. What action can you take this week to seek to make it right, regardless of the other person's response? *Consider praying this week about planning a conversation to confess, apologize, and share your steps for growth with that person.*
