- 3. Read 1 Timothy 5:3-8. Why should each person or family take responsibility to support family members?
- 4. For each of the following passages, list what God instructs believers to do regarding orphans, widows, or the sojourner: Exodus 22:22; Deuteronomy 26:12-13; Psalm 27:10; Psalm 146:9.
- 5. Read Deuteronomy 24:17-22. What did God instruct His people to do in their everyday lives with regard to orphans and vulnerable people? Why was this important and necessary?
- 6. How does our church or our small groups support those who need help?
