- 2. Read John 4:7-15. Where did the Samaritan woman try to find purpose and meaning for her life? What are some of the places or things people turn to try to find meaning, purpose, or value for their lives today?
- 3. For Christians, the decision to follow Jesus is the biggest change in their lives. What are the big changes that have taken place in your life as a result of your relationship with Christ?
- 4. Read John 3:14-18. What human need does verse 16 address? What does it mean to "believe" in Jesus? Can someone believe in Jesus, but not follow Him or live like Him?
- 5. Read Ephesians 2:8-9. Why is that hard for most people to receive a gift and not want to reciprocate the gesture or pay back in some way? How do you think we try to do that with God?
- 6. Read John 10:10 and 17:3. Have you ever thought about eternal life as a way of living or quality of life not just a future reality? Do you think you're experiencing this type of life today? Why or why not?
- 7. What can we do to keep our relationship with Jesus the center of our lives this week? How cand we tell if we are doing this?
