## **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. Who is a current or previous leader who helped point you to God or draw you closer to Him?
- 2. **Read Exodus 11.** Compare and contrast how Moses and Pharaoh acted as leaders. How did they serve themselves, their god(s), and their people?
- 3. Read Exodus 11:2-3. In this passage and the rest of chapter 11 we see how God graces His people with provisions so they may worship Him and honor Him. What are some examples of how money and possessions can be used to worship God and honor Him today?
- 4. How does generosity in the life of a non-Christian look different from a follower of Christ?
- 5. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. What does this passage say to avoid or not do? What does it encourage you to do instead, as you relate to money and possessions?
- 6. In the last few years, how has your generosity changed in your use of time, money, and possessions? Which has shrunk, plateaued, or increased, and why?
- 7. Describe what would it look like a year from now if you were a more generous person? What's one step you could take this week or month to grow in your generosity?
