Ephesians 3:16-20 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

We serve an amazing God -- we serve an all-powerful God— A God without limits. El Shaddai is the Hebrew name for God the all powerful.

This evokes His omnipotence as the Almighty.

It means God most powerful or God Almighty.

He is the creator of all that we see and all that we cannot see.

Colossians 1:16 “For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him.”

Knowing this, we must also know that He is the source of UNLIMITED resources that he gladly gives to his children.

The bible tells us that He EMPOWERS us with INNER strength through His spirit.

We all have two sides to us.

We have the outer man and then we have the inner man.

The outer man is what people see. Who we show the world.

The inner man is the one who you really are.

To have the INNER man strengthened by the Spirit is to have our feelings, thoughts, and purposes placed more and more under His influence and direction.

So that the Spirit can manifest His power through us in greater measure.

We all need our inner man strengthened.

When things happen in life it's our inner man that is TESTED; it's our inner man that is CHALLENGED; it's our inner man that BATTLES.

This is where we need strength to keep going on.

To many people give up during or after something tragic happens in life.

Let me let you know that in life, we are going to have trouble; and tragedy; and hurt; and misery; and tears; and wounds; that is life.

That is why we need to know that outer strength can only carry us so far; BUT inner strength can take you further than you can imagine.

We need this inner strength from the Spirit of God.

What we need on a constant basis in our lives is the presence of God.

1. His Presence

That Christ may establish His presence in our hearts.

Through Christ is the source of Spiritual power for life.

When we have God's presence inside our hearts.

It seems that when we are at our low points in life and it feels like God is a million miles away then we turn our focus on Him and immediately we are filled with the presence of His peace and comfort.

The presence of God makes all the difference.

When Daniel was in the lion's den; the lions did not harm him because the presence of God was with Daniel.

When Shadrach, Meshack and Abendigo were in the fiery furnace; the flames did not harm them because the presence of the Lord was with them.

When Paul was stung by a snake bite him; the people thought he was going to die but he did not because the presence of God was with him.

Some of you are here today because of the presence of God.

That car wreck should have killed you.

That divorce should have finished you off.

That tragedy in your life should have destroyed you but because of the presence of the God, the enemy could not touch you.

Once we have His presence, we can experience His love.

2. His Love

We need His strength in order to be grounded in sincere love for God and others.

Love is what keeps us strong.

Love is what causes us to do things we would not normally do.

Love is what makes us feel alive. Love is what makes us say, do and act in faith.

Love is the source of our strength.

Christ love is great in every dimension

Romans 8:38-39 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers,
³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

This caused people to experience freedom; to experience freedom; to shout: to sing; to dance.

3. His Power

How many believers do I have in the house?

Ephesians 3:20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,

If you have Jesus Christ in your heart, if you know Jesus is in your life, you have a power that very few have tapped into.

We have His power inside of us.

Simply because where ever the presence of God is; His power is also.

God is omnipotent whether we believe it or not. (Having unlimited power)

But it is vitally important that we do believe He is omnipotent.

He is also omnipresent; He is everywhere. He is here; He is there, He is in our present and our future and our past.

When we grasp or get an understanding of the power of God, it will transform our thinking and our actions.

Ephesians 3:20 (KJV) Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, What have you not accomplished that you know you need to do.

God will help you according to what you believe you can do.

But if you believe for Big, He will help you in the Big.
