ZACHARIAH 9:9

Rejoice greatly, daughter of Zion! Shout
in triumph, daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, your king is coming to you; He is
righteous and endowed with salvation,
Humble, and mounted on a donkey,
Even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

LUKE 19:28-40

After Jesus said these things, He was going on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.
²⁹ When He approached Bethphage and Bethany, near the mountain that is called Olivet, He sent two of the disciples, ³⁰ saying, "Go into the village ahead of you; there, as you enter, you will find a colt tied, on which no one yet has ever sat; untie it and bring it here.

³¹ And if anyone asks you, ‘Why are you untying it?’ you shall say this: ‘The Lord has need of it.’” ³² So those who were sent left and found it just as He had told them. ³³ And as they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, “Why are you untying the colt?” ³⁴ They said, “The Lord has need of it.”

³⁵ And they brought it to Jesus, and they threw their cloaks on the colt and put Jesus on it. ³⁶ Now as He was going, they were spreading their cloaks on the road.

³⁷ And as soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles which they had seen,
³⁸ shouting: "BLESSED IS the King, THE ONE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

³⁹ And yet some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Him, “Teacher, rebuke Your disciples!” ⁴⁰ Jesus replied, “I tell you, if these stop speaking, the stones will cry out!”

On the next day, when the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,¹³ they took the branches of the palm trees and went out to meet Him, and began shouting, “Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD, indeed, the King of Israel!”


Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!”

DEFINITION

Hosanna: *lit:* [Aramaic] Save, we pray; appeal to God for deliverance; Please Save Us; Praise God; Pray, Save Us.

WHAT'S THE DEAL WITH PALM LEAVES?

- Palm leaves were a symbol of victory
- The ancients would adorn their heads with palm leaves and crowds would cheer with palm branches for victors.



LUKE 19:41-44

When He approached Jerusalem, He saw the city and wept over it, saying, "If you had known on this day, even you, the conditions for peace! But now they have been hidden from your eyes."

LUKE 19:41-44

“For the days will come upon you when your enemies will put up a barricade against you, and surround you and hem you in on every side, and they will level you to the ground, and throw down your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation.”

JESUS WEEPS OVER JERUSALEM

Just after the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, Jesus weeps as the very people He came to save would reject them, miss their hour of visitation and would call for His crucifixion.

MARK 11:12-14

On the next day, when they had left Bethany, He became hungry. Seeing from a distance a fig tree in leaf, He went to see if perhaps He would find anything on it; and when He came to it, He found nothing but leaves, for it was not the season for figs. And He said to it, "May no one ever eat fruit from you again!" And His disciples were listening.

2 TIMOTHY 4:1-2

I solemnly exhort you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; correct, rebuke, and exhort, with great patience and instruction.

MATTHEW 21:20-22

Seeing this, the disciples were amazed and asked, “How did the fig tree wither all at once?” And Jesus answered and said to them, “Truly I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, ‘Be taken up and cast into the sea,’ it will happen. “And whatever you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive it all.”

Now there were some Greeks among those who were going up to worship at the feast; ²¹ these people then came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and were making a request of him, saying, “Sir, we wish to see Jesus.”

22 Philip *came and *told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip *came and *told Jesus. 23 But Jesus *answered them by saying, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. 24 Truly, truly I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.

JOHN 12:20-26

²⁵ The one who loves his life loses it, and the one who hates his life in this world will keep it to eternal life. ²⁶ If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him.
