HISTORY OF FATHER'S DAY

- oJuly 5, 1908, a West Virginia Church sponsored the first ever event to celebrate fathers.
- oJune 19, 1910, Washington State became the first State to celebrate Father's Day.
- oIn 1916, President Woodrow Wilson pressed a button in Washington D.C. that unfurled an USA flag in Spokane, WA.
- oIn 1924, President Calvin Coolidge urged State Governors to observe Father's Day.
- oIn 1972, President Richard Nixon signed an executive order to official make Father's Day a national holiday.

GENESIS 2:18
