## ACTS 1:1–8 NASB95

The first account I composed, Theophilus,  
about all that Jesus began to do and teach, <sup>2</sup>

<sup>4</sup> Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me; <sup>5</sup> for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

<sup>6</sup> So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?" <sup>7</sup> He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority;

<sup>8</sup> but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

## MATTHEW 25:31-46 NASB95

"But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. <sup>32</sup> "All the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; <sup>33</sup> and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left.

stranger, and you invited Me in;

<sup>36</sup> naked, and you clothed Me; I was sick, and you visited Me; I was in prison, and you came to Me.' <sup>37</sup> "Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, and feed You, or thirsty, and give You something to drink? <sup>38</sup> 'And when did we see You a stranger, and invite You in, or naked, and clothe You?

<sup>39</sup> 'When did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' <sup>40</sup> 'The King will answer and say to them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these brothers of Mine, even the least of them, you did it to Me.'

<sup>41</sup> "Then He will also say to those on His left,  
'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the  
eternal fire which has been prepared for the  
devil and his angels; <sup>42</sup> for I was hungry, and you  
gave Me nothing to eat; I was thirsty, and you  
gave Me nothing to drink;

## MATTHEW 25:31–46 NASB95

<sup>43</sup> I was a stranger, and you did not invite Me in; naked, and you did not clothe Me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit Me.' <sup>44</sup> "Then they themselves also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not take care of You?'

## MATTHEW 25:31–46 NASB95

<sup>45</sup> "Then He will answer them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' <sup>46</sup> "These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

## HEBREWS 13:1-6 NASB95

Let love of the brethren continue. <sup>2</sup> Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by this some have entertained angels without knowing it. <sup>3</sup> Remember the prisoners, as though in prison with them, and those who are ill-treated, since you yourselves also are in the body.
