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# QUESTION 1

*Who gets the glory?*

## MATTHEW 6:16-18

“Now whenever you fast, do not make a gloomy face as the hypocrites do, for they distort their faces so that they will be noticed by people when they are fasting. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full.

## MATTHEW 6:16-18

<sup>17</sup> But as for you, when you fast,  
anoint your head and wash your face,  
<sup>18</sup> so that your fasting will not be  
noticed by people but by your Father  
who is in secret; and your Father who  
sees what is done in secret will  
reward you.

## QUESTION 2

*What do you Treasure?*

## MATTHEW 6:19–21

“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.<sup>20</sup> But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal;<sup>21</sup> for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

## MATTHEW 6:22–23

“The eye is the lamp of the body; so then, if your eye is clear, your whole body will be full of light. <sup>23</sup> But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. So if the light that is in you is darkness, how great is the darkness!

## MATTHEW 6:24

“No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.



## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:1-6

Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we received mercy, we do not lose heart,<sup>2</sup> but we have renounced the things hidden because of shame, not walking in craftiness or adulterating the word of God, but by the manifestation of truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:1-6

<sup>3</sup> And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, <sup>4</sup> in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:1-6

<sup>5</sup> For we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake. <sup>6</sup> For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

## QUESTION 3

*Where do you invest?*

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:7–12

But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, so that the surpassing greatness of the power will be of God and not from ourselves; <sup>8</sup> we are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not despairing; <sup>9</sup> persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed;

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:7–12

<sup>10</sup> always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. <sup>11</sup> For we who live are constantly being delivered over to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. <sup>12</sup> So death works in us, but life in you.

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:13-15

But having the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, “I believed, therefore I spoke,” we also believe, therefore we also speak,<sup>14</sup> knowing that He who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and will present us with you.

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:13-15

<sup>15</sup> For all things are for your sakes, so that the grace which is spreading to more and more people may cause the giving of thanks to abound to the glory of God.



## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:16–18

Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day.<sup>17</sup> For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison,

## 2 CORINTHIANS 4:16–18

<sup>18</sup> while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

# FOCUSING ON THE ETERNAL

- Our inner man is decaying
- This world is temporary
- We have been given a promise, through Christ of a glorious hope to come

## MATTHEW 6:19–21

## MARK 8:35-38

And He summoned the crowd together with His disciples, and said to them, “If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me. <sup>35</sup>For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel’s will save it.

## MARK 8:35-38

<sup>36</sup>For what does it benefit a person to gain the whole world, and forfeit his soul? <sup>37</sup>For what could a person give in exchange for his soul?

## MARK 8:35-38

<sup>38</sup>For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will also be ashamed of him when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.”
