## JOHN 16:1-4 NASB95

"These things I have spoken to you so that you may be kept from stumbling. <sup>2</sup>

"They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God.

## JOHN 16:1-4 NASB95

<sup>3</sup> "These things they will do because they have not known the Father or Me. <sup>4</sup>  
"But these things I have spoken to you, so that when their hour comes, you may remember that I told you of them. These things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

## JOHN 16:5-15 NASB95

"But now I am going to Him who sent Me; and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' <sup>6</sup> "But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart.

## JOHN 16:5-15 NASB95

<sup>7</sup> "But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. <sup>8</sup>

"And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment;

## JOHN 16:5-15 NASB95

<sup>9</sup> concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; <sup>10</sup> and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; <sup>11</sup> and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

## JOHN 16:5-15 NASB95

<sup>12</sup> "I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. <sup>13</sup> "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

## JOHN 16:5-15 NASB95

<sup>14</sup> "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose *it* to you. <sup>15</sup> "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose *it* to you.
