## MATTHEW 15:1-14 NASB95

Then some Pharisees and scribes came to Jesus from Jerusalem and said, <sup>2</sup> "Why do Your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat bread." <sup>3</sup> And He answered and said to them, "Why do you yourselves transgress the commandment of God for the sake of your tradition?"

# MATTHEW 15:1-14 NASB95

<sup>4</sup> "For God said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER,' and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER IS TO BE PUT TO DEATH.' <sup>5</sup>

"But you say, 'Whoever says to his father or mother, "Whatever I have that would help you has been given to God,"

## MATTHEW 15:1-14 NASB95

<sup>6</sup> he is not to honor his father or his mother.' And by this you invalidated the word of God for the sake of your tradition. <sup>7</sup> "You hypocrites, rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you: <sup>8</sup> 'THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME. <sup>9</sup> 'BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'"

## MATTHEW 15:1-14 NASB95

<sup>10</sup> After Jesus called the crowd to Him, He said to them, "Hear and understand. <sup>11</sup> "It is not what enters into the mouth that defiles the man, but what proceeds out of the mouth, this defiles the man." <sup>12</sup> Then the disciples came and said to Him, "Do You know that the Pharisees were offended when they heard this statement?"

## MATTHEW 15:1-14 NASB95

<sup>13</sup> But He answered and said, "Every plant which My heavenly Father did not plant shall be uprooted. <sup>14</sup> "Let them alone; they are blind guides of the blind. And if a blind man guides a blind man, both will fall into a pit."

## MATTHEW 15:15–20 NASB95

Peter said to Him, "Explain the parable to us." <sup>16</sup>

Jesus said, "Are you still lacking in understanding also? <sup>17</sup> "Do you not understand that everything that goes into the mouth passes into the stomach, and is eliminated?"

## MATTHEW 15:15–20 NASB95

<sup>18</sup> "But the things that proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and those defile the man.

<sup>19</sup> "For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, slanders. <sup>20</sup> "These are the things which defile the man; but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile the man."

## MATTHEW 15:21–28 NASB95

Jesus went away from there, and withdrew into the district of Tyre and Sidon. <sup>22</sup> And a Canaanite woman from that region came out and began to cry out, saying, "Have mercy on me, Lord, Son of David; my daughter is cruelly demon-possessed."

## MATTHEW 15:21-28 NASB95

<sup>23</sup> But He did not answer her a word. And His disciples came and implored Him, saying, "Send her away, because she keeps shouting at us." <sup>24</sup> But He answered and said, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." <sup>25</sup> But she came and began to bow down before Him, saying, "Lord, help me!"

## MATTHEW 15:21-28 NASB95

<sup>26</sup> And He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs."  
<sup>27</sup> But she said, "Yes, Lord; but even the dogs feed on the crumbs which fall from their masters' table."  
<sup>28</sup> Then Jesus said to her, "O woman, your faith is great; it shall be done for you as you wish."  
And her daughter was healed at once.

## REVELATION 22:12-16 NASB95

"Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done. <sup>13</sup> "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." <sup>14</sup> Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter by the gates into the city.

<sup>15</sup> Outside are the dogs and the sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying. <sup>16</sup> "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star."
